SURFACE PREPARATION

Metal	Remove old paint, rust, and any contaminants completely. Wipe the surface clean with thinner until free from dust, dirt, grease, or any foreign matter. Ensure the surface is thoroughly dry.
Wood	For wooden surfaces, ensure the surface is clean and free from dust, wood splinters, grease, and any flaking or peeling paint. For a smoother finish, lightly sand the surface and wipe it again with a clean cloth before applying wood primer.
Other Surfaces	Clean the surface thoroughly to remove dust, grease, or any contaminants. Ensure the surface is completely dry. For glossy or smooth surfaces, lightly sand with fine-grit sandpaper to enhance paint adhesion.

PAINT SYSTEM

Metal Primer	Spray Nippon Paint Lazer using the designated primer shade as specified in the catalog (1 coat).
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Wood Primer	Apply Nippon Paint Bodelac Undercoat White to prevent mold and fill wood grains, or spray Nippon Paint Lazer using the designated primer shade as specified in the catalog (1 coat).
Topcoat	Spray Nippon Paint Lazer for 2 coats, or until the surface is fully covered.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Ensure the surface is clean and free from rust, dust, grease, and any other contaminants.
2. Shake the can vigorously before use until the mixing ball rattles. Shake occasionally during use to maintain even mixing.
3. Apply a suitable primer as recommended in the product catalogue to achieve the desired finish and color.
4. Spray in thin, even coats. Allow each coat to dry for at least 10 minutes before applying the next. Avoid applying a thick coat in one go, as it may cause sagging or improper drying.
5. Hold the can approximately 30 cm from the surface while spraying for optimal coverage.
6. After use, turn the can upside down and spray briefly to clear the nozzle and prevent clogging.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

Storage condition	This is a pressurized container. Do not puncture, pierce, or incinerate, even when empty. Store in a dry, well-ventilated area with the lid tightly closed. Avoid direct sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 40°C. During storage or transport, keep containers properly spaced and segregated from other materials. Flammable substances such as oil-based paints and thinners must be stored separately from other product types to ensure safety.
Precipitation	Leaving paint cans unused for extended periods can cause the pigment to settle and deteriorate over time. If the can is not shaken thoroughly before use, it may lead to issues such as uneven color, poor coverage, or inconsistent finish during application.
Shelf life	3 years at 30 - 35 °C
