

# Using .ASE Swatch Files in Adobe Illustrator / Photoshop / InDesign

## ● .ASE Adobe Illustrator (AI)

- Open or create a file in Illustrator
- Go to Window > Swatches
- Click the top-right menu of the Swatches panel > Open Swatch Library > Other Library...
- Browse and select your .ASE file
- The swatches will appear in a new panel. Drag them into your main swatch panel to use

## ● .ASE Adobe Photoshop (PSD))

- Open or create a file in Photoshop
- Go to Window > Swatches
- Click the > menu on the Swatches panel
- Choose Import Swatches...
- Select your .ASE file > Click Open
- Colors will appear in your swatch panel

⚠ Note: Some versions of Photoshop do not support .ASE directly. You may need to convert it to .ACO or use Adobe Bridge.

## ● .ASE Adobe InDesign

- Open or create a document in InDesign
- Go to Window > Color > Swatches
- Click the panel menu (top right corner)
- Select Load Swatches...
- Choose your .ASE file ☒ Click Open
- Swatches will be imported into your current palette
